


Chutney Chicken Curry

Before you start

Diced Chicken Breast	260 g	520 g
Curry Powder	2 sachets	4 sachets
Cranberry Chutney	1 sachet	2 sachets
Shallot	1 unit	2 units
Green Beans	150 g	300 g
Chicken Stock	1 sachet	2 sachets
Garlic	1 unit	2 units
Creme Fraiche	110 g	220 g
Rice	150 g	300 g
Coriander	5 g	10 g

Boil the Rice

- Pour 300ml cold **salted water** (double for 4p) into a medium pot with a tight-fitting lid.
- Stir in the rice and bring to the boil.
- Once boiling, lower the heat to medium, cover, and cook for 10 mins.
- Remove the pot from the heat.
- Keep covered for 10 mins or until ready to serve (the **rice** will continue to cook in its own steam).



Prep the Veg

- Meanwhile, halve, peel and thinly slice the shallot.
- Trim the green beans then chop into thirds.
- Peel and grate the **garlic** (or use a garlic press).
- Roughly chop the coriander (stalks and all).



Fry the Chicken

- Place a large pan over medium-high heat with a drizzle of oil.
- Add the chicken and season with salt and pepper.
- Cook until the chicken is browned, 5-6 mins. IMPORTANT: Wash hands after handling raw chicken and its packaging.
- Once the chicken is browned, add the shallot and cook until softened, stirring frequently, 3-4 mins.

TIP: Notice a stronger smell from your chicken? Don't worry, this is normal due to packaging used to keep it fresh.



Simmer the Curry

- Add the garlic and curry powder and stir to coat the chicken. Cook for 1 min.
- Pour in 100ml water (double for 4p) along with the stock.
- Add the green beans, bring to the boil, then reduce the heat to medium.
- Cover the pan with a lid or some foil.
- Simmer until the green beans are tender, 5-7 mins.



Finishing Touches

- Once the green beans are tender and the chicken is cooked, remove the lid from the pan and stir in the creme fraiche and cranberry chutney.
 IMPORTANT: Chicken is cooked when no longer pink in the middle.
- Bring to the boil, then remove from the heat.
- Stir through half the coriander.
- Taste and season with **salt** and **pepper** if desired.



Dish Up

- Fluff up the rice with a fork and divide between bowls.
- · Top with the chicken curry.
- Finish with a sprinkling of the remaining **coriander**.
